"As a proven IaaS specialist, we will be able to offer new functions in the future that will make operating the virtual servers even more simple for the system administrators and DevOps engineers," announced Xelon CEO Michael Dudli.

In order to further expand the infrastructure and the services, the start-up, headquartered in Zug, already moved into space in the Green data center in the summer. "As our stringent data protection and security standards mean that 'Made in Switzerland' is of great importance to Xelon, Green's five data centers in Switzerland and its outstanding record of achievement make the company our ideal partner," explained Xelon CEO Dudli. Since July 2020, Xelon has boasted ISO 9001 and 27001 certifications for quality management and cyber security respectively, guaranteeing the comprehensive, rigorous information security standards that the company is known for.

This step will further raise the importance of the Green cloud ecosystem and, with Xelon, it has gained a new partner. "We aim to join together with partners across all the key technological fields to ensure rapid growth of the ecosystem and thus to provide companies with a full-range offering from our data centers for their cloud journey," explained Roger Süess, CEO of Green, who added, "we are thereby fulfilling our pledge of supporting companies with the modernization of their IT, both across-the-board and with long-term vision." More joint customer projects are already planned.
